

- 2. - (b) in any other case, within 21 days after the first publication of the notice of intention.
- (2) The notice of objection shall state:
 - (a) the name and address of the person objecting,
 - (b) the nature of the objection,
 - (c) the grounds on which the objection is based, and
 - (d) the nature of the interest of the person objecting.
- 6. A person affected by the proposed expropriation does not need to serve an objection to the expropriation in order to preserve his right to have the amount of compensation payable determined by the Land Compensation Board or the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta, as the case may be.
